STANDARD PROCEDURE: RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR ELECTED
POSITIONS**

I. PURPOSE

To outline residency requirements for elected members of the Board of Directors in order to ensure involvement, commitment and familiarity with California emergency nursing issues.

II. PROCEDURE

- A. In order to remain a member of the Board of Directors in good status, the Director must be a member of the California State Council. In addition, one of the following requirements must be met:
 - i. The Director must be a resident of California; or
 - ii. The Director's primary place of employment must be at a California health care institution or agency.
- B. If a Director no longer meets residency requirements, a letter of resignation shall be sent to the State Council Board of Directors.
- C. Vacancies on the Board due to residency issues will be filled according to Article IX, Section F of the *Bylaws*.
